Applications are invited Online only from qualified candidates for appointment in the under mentioned post in various Universities in Kerala. Before applying for the post the candidates should register as per the One Time Registration through the official website of Kerala Public Service Commission. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile.

1. **Department** : **Universities in Kerala**
2. **Name of Post** : **Overseer Gr II (Civil)**
3. **Scale of pay** : **₹ 31,100 – 66,800/-**
4. **Number of vacancy** : **Anticipated vacancies**

The Ranked list published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year and a maximum period of three years provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancies if any reported to the Commission during the currency of the list.

**Note :-** i) This notification will be applicable to selection to the above mentioned post in all the Universities mentioned in Rule 2a (i to xiii) of the Kerala Public Service Commission (Additional Functions as respects the Service under the Universities) Act 2015 and of the Universities added in this Act as per law in due course.

- ii) A common ranked list will be published in pursuance of this notification for all the Universities and candidates will be advised from that list against all the vacancies reported for the post from all the Universities mentioned above. As such, a candidate need to send only one application. Candidates will be advised for recruitment to each University according to the order in which vacancies are reported from each University and in accordance with the ranks secured by them subject to the rules of reservation and rotation in force. Once advised his/her turn will be over and he/she will have no further claim for being considered for appointment from the ranked list to another University. As common ranked list is prepared for more than one University on the basis of a common examination, a candidate appointed in a University and relieved for want of vacancy can register his/her name in the office of Kerala Public Service Commission and in such case he/she will be advised for appointment against the next vacancy reported from any of the above mentioned University. His/her service in the former University will be counted for probation in the latter University. For reappointment in the present University itself, no registration is necessary but one has to wait till vacancy arises in that University. Candidates will have no right to claim initial appointment to any particular University.

5. **Method of appointment** : Direct Recruitment
6. **Age limit** : 18-36, Only candidates born between 02.01.1989 and 01.01.2007 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post with usual relaxation to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Communities. (For conditions regarding the age relaxation please see Part II Para 2 of the General Conditions).

**Note** : For concessions allowed in upper age limit, subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 years, please see para (2) of the General Conditions under Part II of this Notification.

7. **Qualifications** : 3 years recognized Diploma or equivalent qualification in the concerned subject (Civil).

OR

SSLC or equivalent qualification and any of the following qualifications :

- a) Government of Kerala Certificate (Two Year Course in Draftsman Civil)

OR

- b) Diploma in Draftsmanship in Civil Trade in 18 months course (6 months with practical training) at Industrial Training Institute/ Center, Ministry of Labour, Government of India.

**Note :-**

1. Rule 10 a (ii) of Part II of KS&SSR is applicable.

In addition to the qualifications prescribed in this notification, the qualifications recognized by executive orders or standing orders of Government as equivalent to a qualification specified for a post, in the Special Rules or found acceptable by the Commission in cases where acceptance of equivalent qualifications is provided for in the rules and such of those qualifications which pre-suppose the acquisition of the lower qualification prescribed for the post, shall also be sufficient for the post. The copy of the Government orders declaring equivalent/ higher qualifications shall be produced as and when required by the Commission.

2. Candidates who claim equivalent qualification instead of qualification mentioned in the notification shall produce the relevant Government Order to prove the equivalency at the time of verification, then only such qualification shall be treated as equivalent to the prescribed qualification concerned.
3. In the case of difference in original caste/ community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC book, the candidate shall produce a Gazette notification in this regard, along with Non Creamy Layer Certificate/ Community Certificate at the time of certificate verification.

**8. Probation:-** Every person appointed to the post shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years duty within a continuous period of three years, during which the candidates selected shall pass departmental test for declaring probation.

**9. Method of submitting applications :-**

- (a) Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission [www.keralapsc.gov.in](http://www.keralapsc.gov.in) before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the '**Apply Now**' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for the post. Candidates creating new profile should upload the photograph taken within six months. Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. **Candidates are advised to keep a printout or soft copy of the online application for future reference. Candidates can take the print out of the application by clicking on the link 'My applications' in their profile. All correspondence with the Commission, regarding the application should be accompanied with the print out of**

**the application.** The application will be summarily rejected if non-compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Original Documents to prove qualification, experience, age, Community etc. have to be produced as and when called for.

- (b) If Written/OMR/Online Test is conducted as part of this selection, candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in the last 15 days till the date of Test. The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period, will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of Admission Tickets will be published in the Examination Calendar itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phone number registered in it.
- (c) As per KPSC Rules of Procedure, Rule 22, disciplinary action shall be taken against those candidates who submit applications making false claims regarding qualifications or experience which causes them disqualifying from being considered for the job for which they apply or debar them from sending applications to the Kerala Public Service Commission permanently or for a fixed period and invalidate the materials made by them in the practical examination for which they appear in or the answer sheets of the written examination and legal action will be taken against them, or If they are appointed to a job, they may be removed from that job, dismissed and other suitable disciplinary/ legal action, or one or more of the above actions may be taken against them.
- (d) Candidates should submit their application after reading and understand the Part II of General Conditions and those applications violating the General Conditions specified shall be rejected.
- (e) “Candidates who have AADHAAR Card should add AADHAAR as ID Proof in their profile.”
